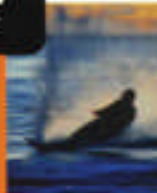

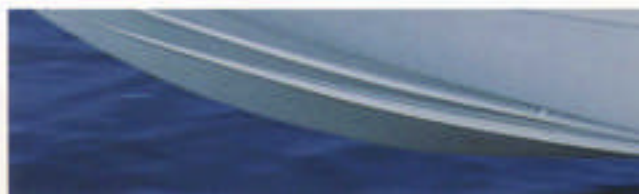

Look, you don't have to understand how a fiberglass boat is built, to know it's built right. One ride will tell you that. Does the boat feel solid in your hands? Can it knock down waves all day without hammering your body? Does it work with the water rather than against it?

At Starcraft, we build fiberglass boats that'll take a beating and still come storming back for more. Whether it's 4-foot, knuckle-busting seas or a boatload of feisty teenagers and their gear, Starcraft boats are built tough from the inside out. How tough? Just look at the illustration below. Or better yet, take a test drive. Then go ahead. Pick a fight with some nasty looking waves.



Is enough ever really enough?

Heck no. At Starcraft, quality control is a never-ending passion. Case in point. To make sure your fiberglass boat is as flawless as possible, we clean and buff each mold after every single use, eliminating any scratches or imperfections.

Fiberglass Construction Process

1 Premium high gloss gelcoat, with 20 mil thickness, is sprayed onto the mold to provide maximum blister resistance and UV protection.

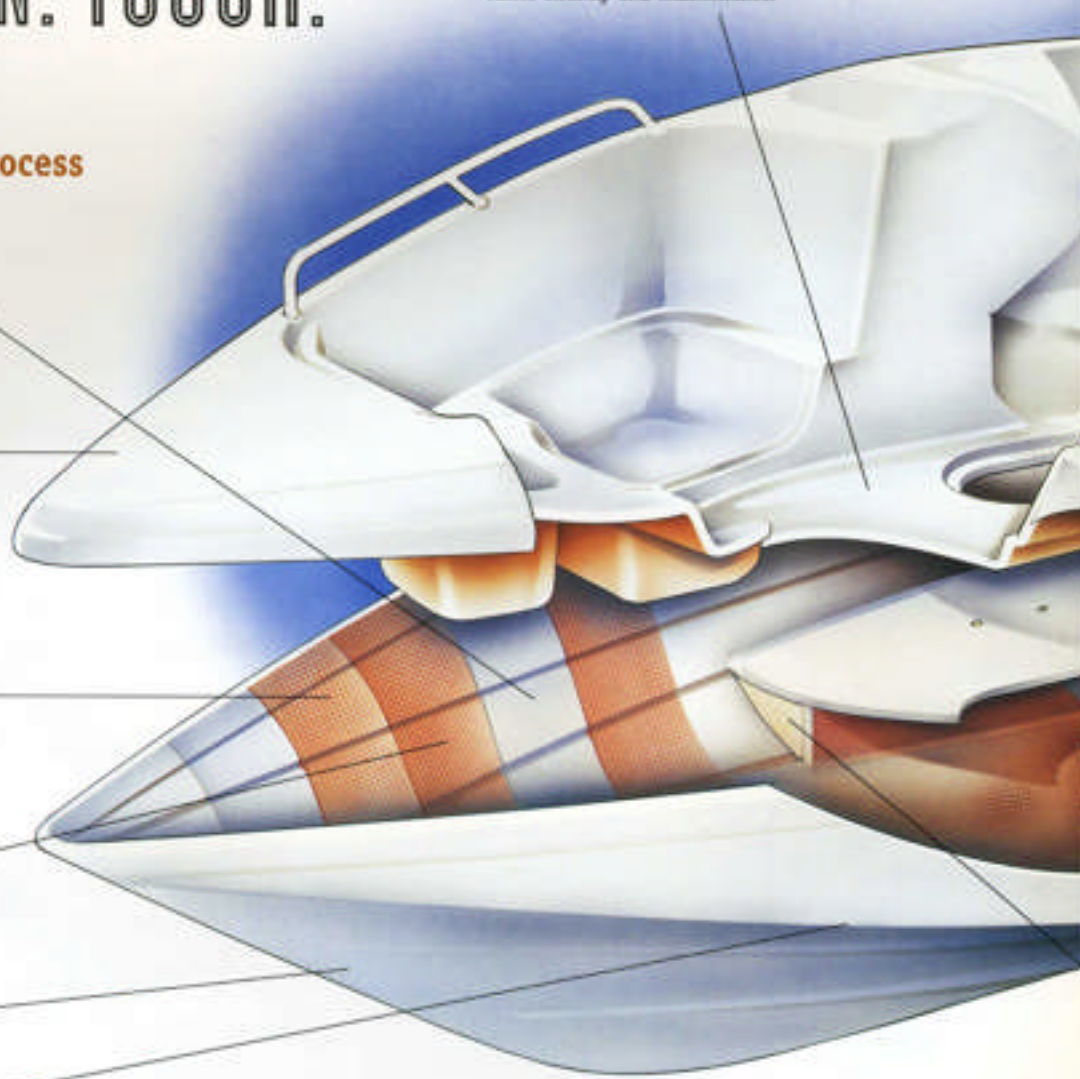
2 Spraycore® barrier coat, with 80 mil thickness, is applied to the sidewalls for greater strength and rigidity with less weight. This process also eliminates hot spots for an improved finish (not done by most competitors).

3 First layer of multidirectional hand-rolled fiberglass, the "skin coat," is applied.

4 Fiberglass is hand laid. Second layer of fiberglass woven roving is applied, along with a balsa core, for greater strength in high-stress areas and less weight.

Fiberglass is applied to high-stress areas for added strength.

Fiberglass is hand laid at all chine and strake lines.



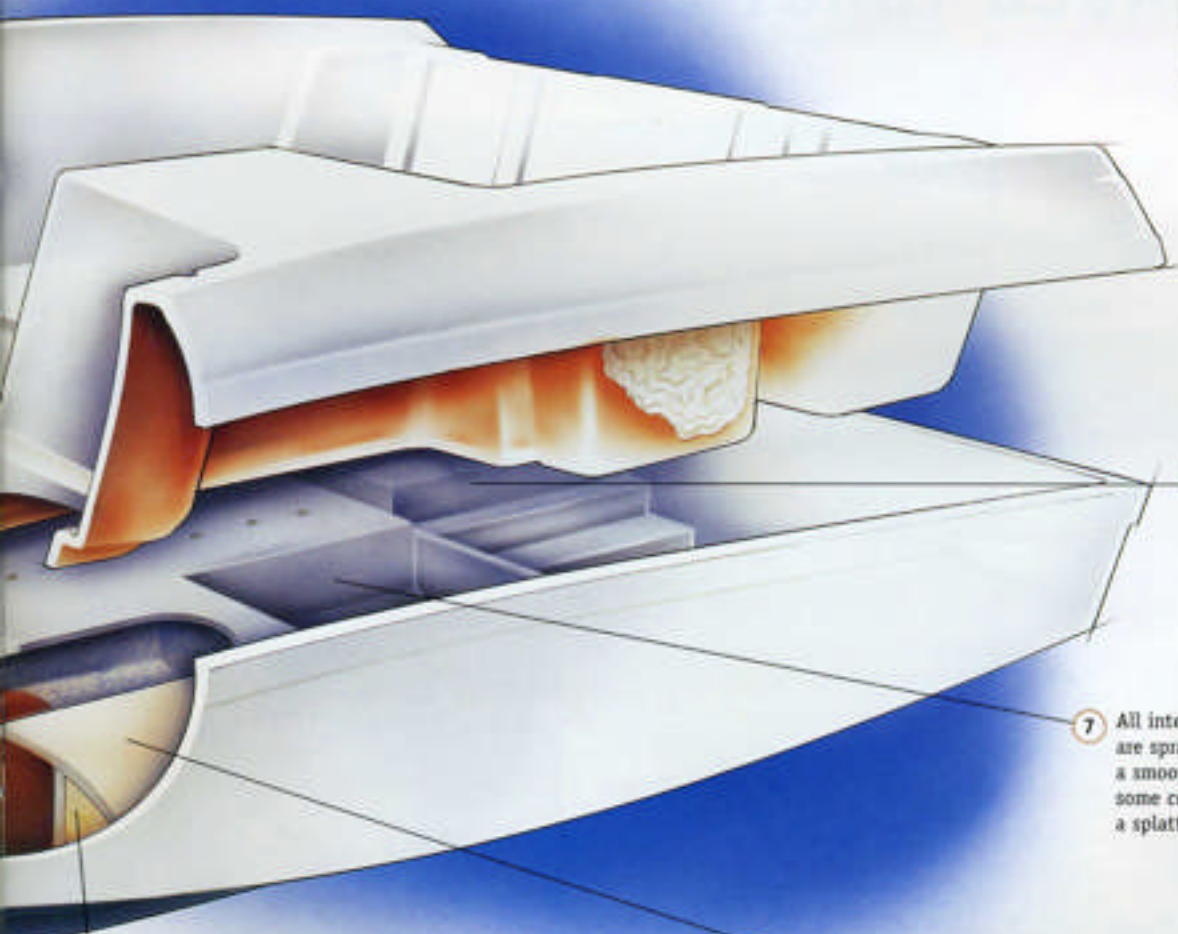
What makes our fiberglass boats so tough?

Well, for starters, the fiberglass itself. At Starcraft, we use 24-ounce woven roving fiberglass instead of 18-ounce like the others. We also insist on a 6-inch overlap between the hull and deck for greater strength and a tighter fit. Our competitors' overlap? Typically, one or two inches. And to assemble the deck and hull, we use a combination of thru-bolt construction and a fierce bonding adhesive that just won't let go.



WARRANTIES

We build Starcraft boats to provide years of superior performance and reliability, and our warranties back up that level of quality construction. Starcraft warrants each fiberglass hull for 5 years. All warranties are based on years of use under normal recommended operating conditions. Please see your authorized Starcraft dealer for complete warranty information.



6 The stringer system below deck is fully encapsulated in fiberglass to lock out moisture.

7 All interior storage compartments are sprayed with a gelcoat finish for a smooth, clean appearance, unlike some competitors who simply spray a splatter coat.

5 All floors are joined to the hull with 24-ounce woven roving fiberglass, followed by a resin coating and a second layer of fiberglass.

8 Foam is injected, not poured, between the hull and the deck, filling all air pockets and preventing water leaks. This process also increases hull strength while it decreases noise and vibrations, giving you a quieter, smoother ride.

- 2. Air Star Tower package:** Optional tower with Sunbrella® top provides out-of-the-way storage for wakeboards, kneeboards, and skis.
