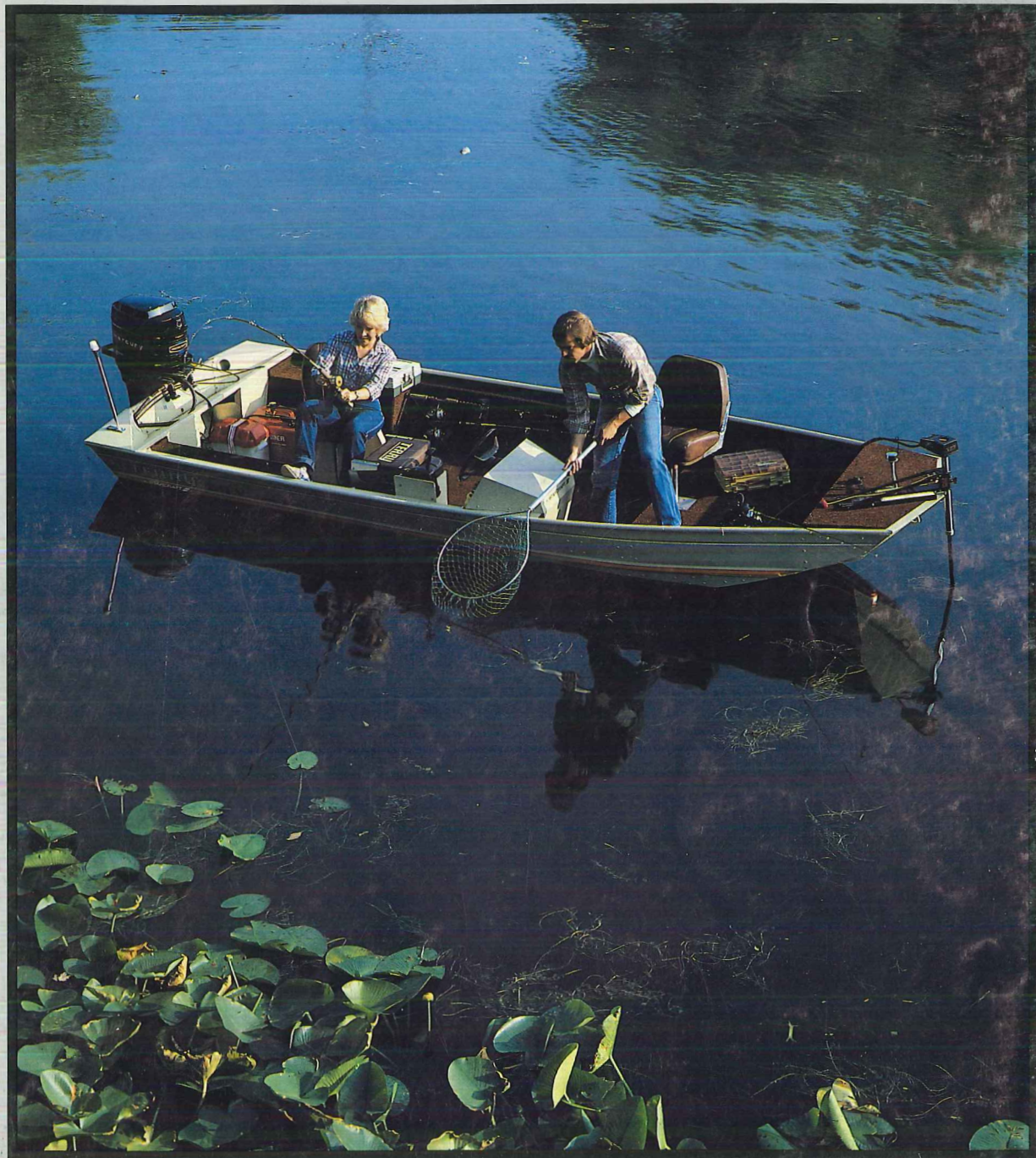

Every Terry boat is produced from durable 5052-H34 marine aluminum alloy; 40% stronger than 5002 marine-grade aluminum used by many boat manufacturers today. It's stronger, yet lighter in weight. The lightweight boat, lightweight trailer, and smaller motor give you the best operating economy on the water today!

We mentioned quality; it begins in little things like rivet sizes of 1 1/4" for maximum grip strength, extra thickness in walls of gunnel extrusions for greater resistance to the rigors years of fishing can put a boat through, special lateral and vertical ribbing construction for increased stress absorption—and arrives at the most rugged and dependable boats on the market today!

Big Water 16V

It's a fish-fighter, like none other of its kind! There's room to accommodate any fisherman—from those that seek the pan-fish to those fighting the large muskie. Its deep-V hull cuts through rough chop to give you a smooth ride. It's durable lightweightness gives excellent performance from less horse-power. This is the boat for the person who wants a big water fishing boat that can be economically operated. Standard features like painted hull and console, marine carpeting, console steering and removeable running lights make it a pleasure to navigate. The standard features of aerated livewell, bilge pump, removeable pedestal seat, fold-down driver and aft seats make it an efficient, easy-to-operate boat.



Sportsman 16V

Benchmark for aluminum bass boats. It has the features and looks of fiberglass boats, but is lightweight and has the durability only aluminum can give. It's made with the same deep-V hull as the Big Water 16V. The Sportsman has bow and stern casting platforms, aerated and divided livewell that help make this a boat that's ideal for the fishing enthusiast who won't come home without them! It's standard with rod storage, bow and stern storage—for the fisherman who takes enough gear to be out there for awhile. Don't let its ruggedness fool you, it's a beauty to look at too—with standard features like marine carpeting, removeable running lights, painted hull and console, two removeable pedestal seats and a bench seat for driver and companion with console steering.

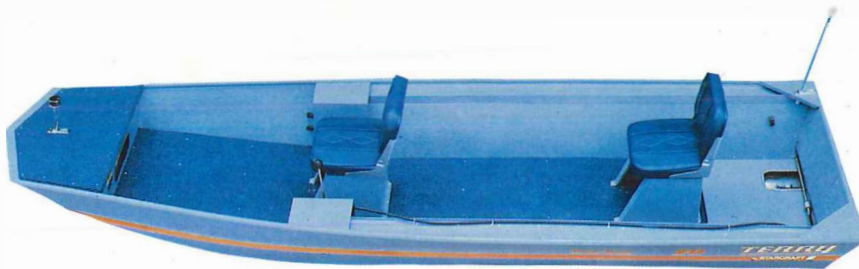

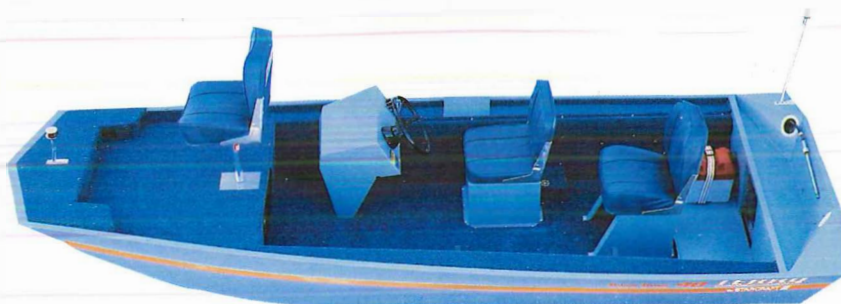
Bass Boss 20

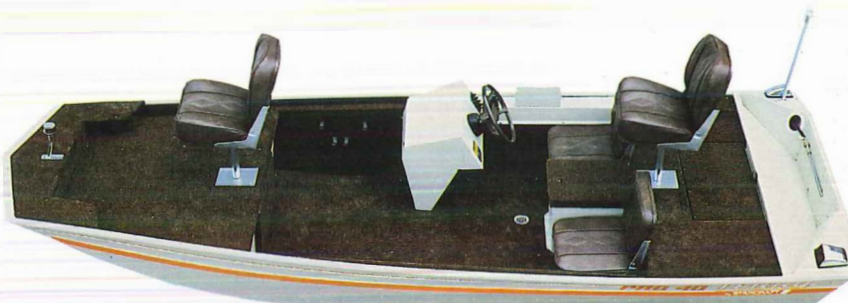
Bass Boss 40

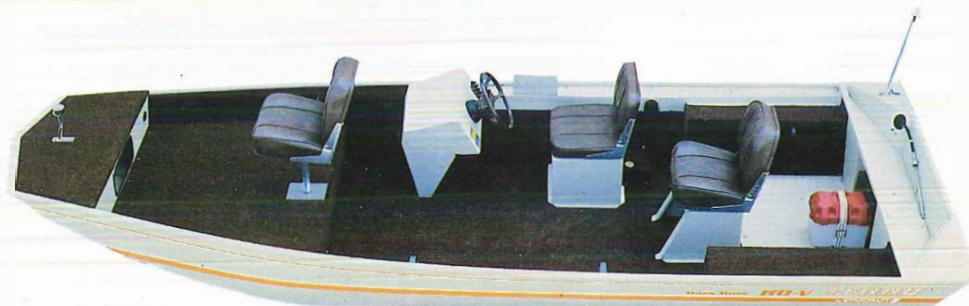
Bass Boss Pro 40

This 14-footer is equipped with the shallow draft hull that makes a flat, stable, fishing platform. The Bass Pro 40 has a durable wood transom, the same as all Terry Bass Boats, for maximum strength—not fiberboard as is commonly used today. Its features are bow and stern casting platforms, recirculating livewell, console steering, and many others sure to appeal to the bass fisherman.



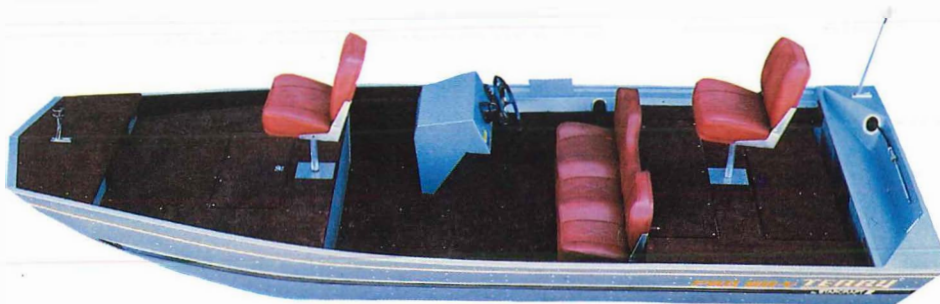
Bass Boss 60

The Bass Boss 60 also utilizes the V-hull construction of the Pro 60 and many of its standard features, but offers a different interior layout. It's quality made—right down to the little items like stainless steel bolts used in the transom area, but you'll get it for an economical initial investment and have years of low-cost operation.



Bass Boss Pro 60

This 'fishing machine' is offered in the modified-V hull. It will give you quick planing and smooth riding. The Pro 60 and all models in the bass boat line use a special "sandwich construction" on the hulls consisting of aluminum, wood and carpeting for maximum strength and durability. Its standard features are ideal for the bass fisherman—aerated and divided livewell, bow and stern casting platforms and console steering, to mention a few.

Jon Boats

All twelve models are made for lasting service to their owners. They're fortified with aluminum rib extrusions that extend up the sides of the boat giving extra strength and making a stable fishing platform. They're roomy, but lightweight enough to be easily portable. They have full plywood, integrated transoms; heavy-duty corner moldings; they're boats that are made to last.

V-boats

Terry built these economically-priced boats to give all the benefits of the V-bottom boats --they plane quickly, perform well. There's plenty of room to haul in the fish, yet they're lightweight enough for a 'car-topper', or to fit easily into the back of your pickup truck.

Cabin Model Jon Boat - 2260-18

This spacious 18' cabin model tops off the Jon boat line. The cabin head room is a full 59". It's a refuge from the elements for the duck hunter and fisherman alike. It's a camouflaged duck blind, or a comfortable resting place. The cabin model Jon boat is big, durable and rugged--but lightweight for towing.
